Please note below the requirements, qualifications, and duties for a Student Instructorship in Italian through the Department of French and Italian.

Duties:

Student Instructors are master teachers for lower- division Italian classes (101, 102, 101-102 accelerated, 201, 211R, 311R). All classes (except 211R/311R) are taught daily. Student Instructors are responsible for preparing classes, making oral and written evaluations, and assigning grades. SIs are required to attend a paid training seminar before the beginning of Fall Semester, and a few training sessions during the academic year. SIs are also expected to support the Italian Club and other department-sponsored activities.

Qualifications: 1.

A senior or junior majoring or minoring in Italian or Italian Studies, or a graduate student, or an Italian native speaker

- 2. 3.0 GPA minimum (staple an ABC report when returning this application- this can be found in MyBYU under the work tab on the right. Click on AIM, student academic record, progress report (ABC Report)).
- 3. Advanced language proficiency in Italian (see point 1 below)
- 4. Excellent recommendations

Requirements: 1. Fill out this application form and submit it to Dr. Klein together with your transcript or ABC report *and* a 3-min. recording of your speaking ability (introduce yourself, relate your experience in Italy, etc. Please do not read a prepared text. Just speak spontaneously into the recording.)

Note: An audio cassette tape or a digital audio file are both acceptable for this portion of the application. If sending the MP3 file electronically, clearly mark the subject file as "audio file for SI application" and send to Ilona Klein@byu.edu.

- 2. Successful applicants will be contacted for an interview after about three weeks.
- 3. A mock-teaching scenario will complete the application process for the most successful applicants.
