Emily Jayne Robinson Scholarship

Description: The Emily Jayne Robinson Scholarship Fund generously supports BYU students studying French by offering need-based scholarships to French majors and minors.

Amount: \$500 - \$2,500 (according to discretion of Gift Fund Committee). Recipients may elect to have funds disbursed at the beginning of the 2022 spring term, summer term, or fall semester.

Qualifications: Applicants must be full-time students of BYU-Provo who are currently declared as a French major/minor, French Studies secondary major, or French Teaching major/minor. Additionally, students must have at least a 3.0 GPA. As per the scholarship fund's stipulations, preference will be given to French-speaking students from Africa and students with greater financial need. While priority is given to these applicants, other students may also receive scholarships.

- Current CV (8.5" x 11" .pdf in English)
- Current BYU grade report (.pdf)
- A brief statement (1–1.5 pages; .pdf; written in English) outlining the applicant's motivation for studying French and how the applicant would benefit from this scholarship.

Additional Requirements: Before funds are disbursed, recipients of the scholarship will be required to write a brief letter (1–1.5 pages) in which they introduce themselves and detail how they benefit from both the scholarship as well as their studies of French. The letter should be submitted to the Gift & Scholarship Fund Committee via email (see below).
